OUR LEARNING

MATHS: Learners continue practicing reading, writing and decomposing 5 digits numbers. They related integer numbers with real life as an introduction to negative numbers. They followed sequences below zero and we studied negative numbers in detail by using a numberline on the workbook. Finally, we commented on test 1 in order to learn from their mistakes.

ENGLISH: We learned ordinal numbers, we also described our favorite month of the year. We reviewed the use of was/were and past tense, and we learned the use of could/couldn't.

SCIENCE: We learned about vertebrates and invertebrates and how muscles and bones work together to allow us to move.
