OUR LEARNING

ENGLISH: We reviewed personal information and school activities.

Phonics: we reviewed letters and sound S-A-T-P-I-N.

MATHS: We practiced quantities: more or less. Cardinal numbers: first, second- third-fourth, until tenth. We also counted from 0 to 10 and completed a number line and we graphed the numbers following points.

LENGUAJE: Conversamos sobre cómo es nuestro barrio y comunidad utilizando lenguaje descriptivo. Separamos palabras en sílabas identificando cuántas sílabas tiene cada palabra. Grafomotricidad: trazos rectos, curvos y quebrados.

SCIENCE: We continued revising five senses: hearing, taste, sight, smell. "I can see with my eyes. I can hear with my ears. I can touch with my hands. I can taste with my mouth and tongue. I can smell with my nose." We tasted different flavours: chips are salty, sugar is sweet, lemon is sour, coffee is bitter.
